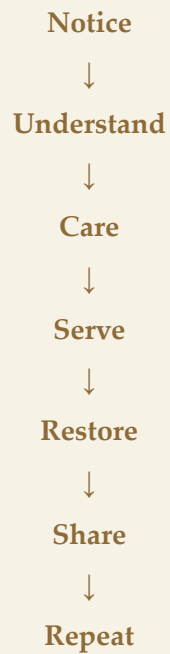
BECOME A STEWARD

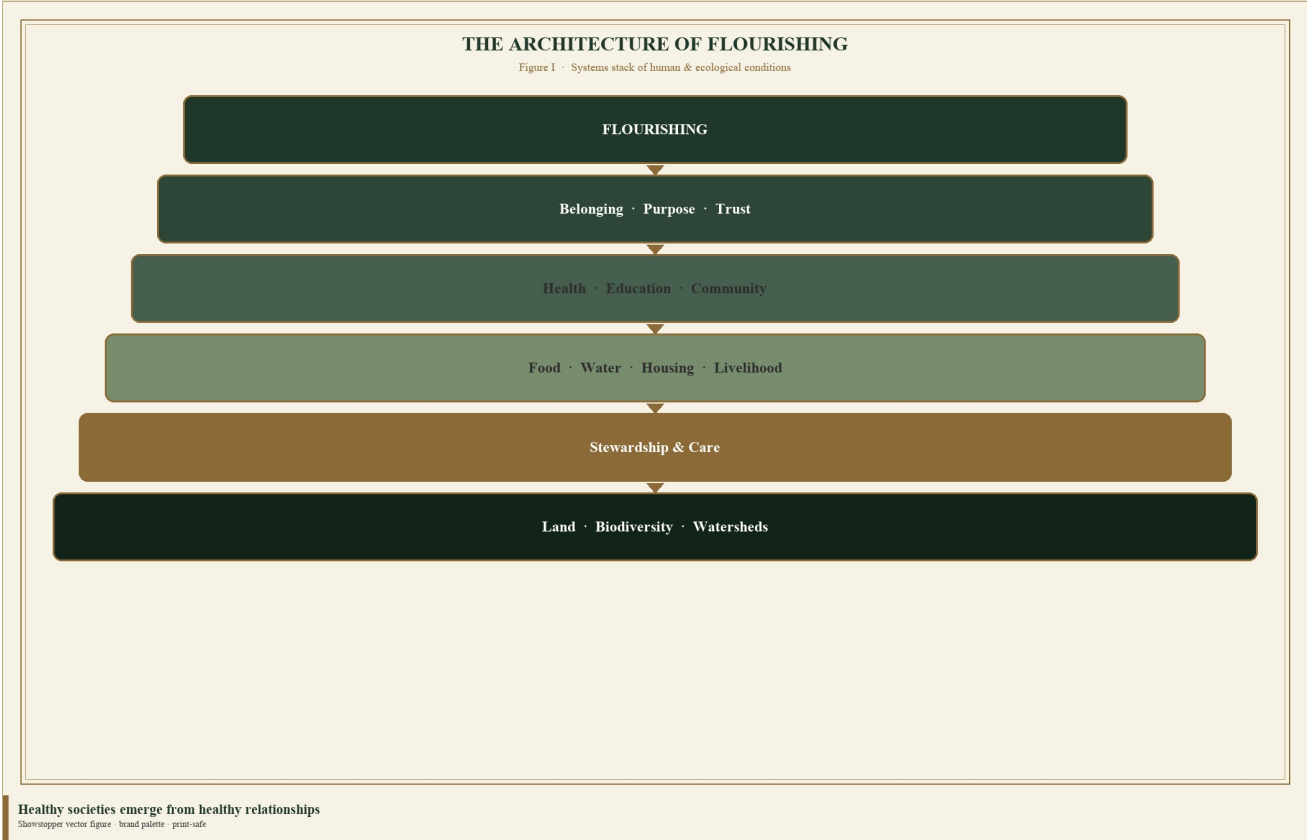

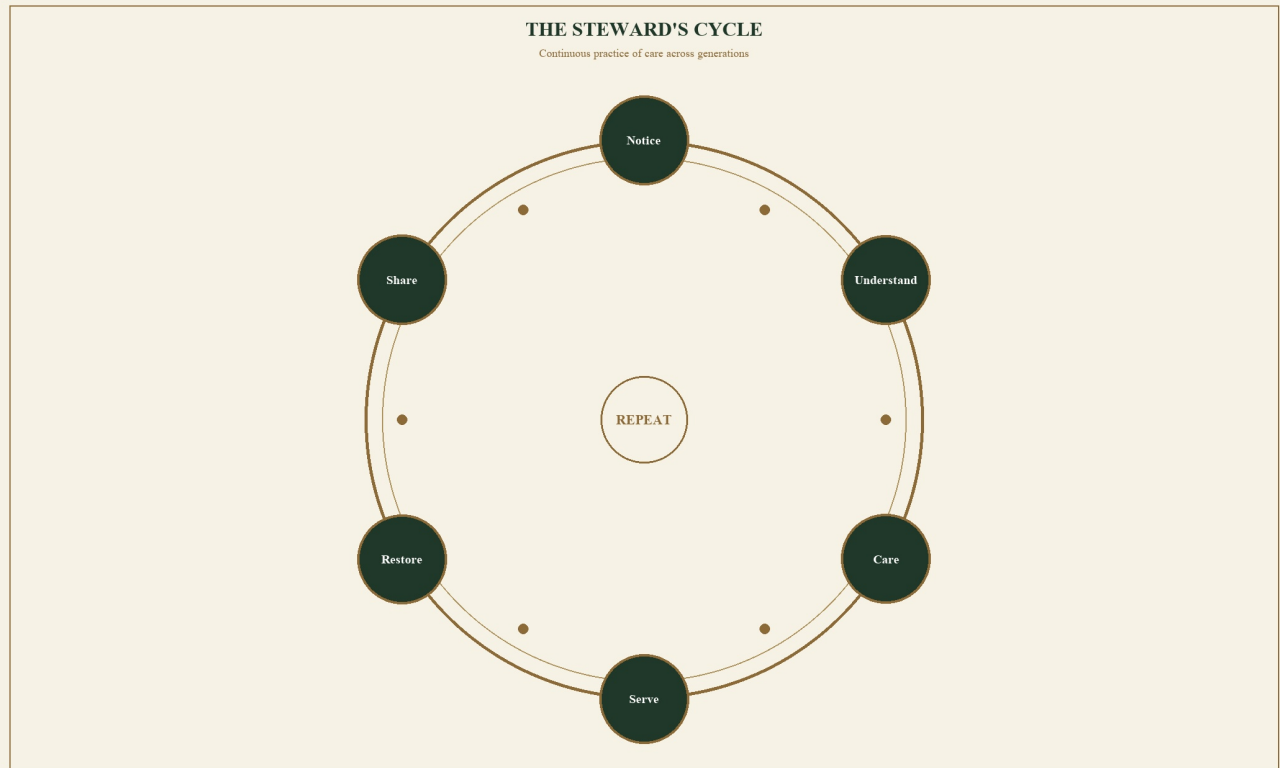


Figure · Continuous practice of care
